# Expanse Delivery Inspection Overview

Many Expanse deliveries are made by a common carrier or a contract hauler. Porchwerx contracts with these carriers to deliver windows to your place of business or jobsites. When the carrier takes possession of the windows and doors from our manufacturing facility, the carrier takes over the responsibility for the care of the windows. The carriers are fully responsible for any damage during the delivery period. Porchwerx is not responsible for any freight damage. Only the trucking companies can cover the cost of the freight damage. These carriers will not consider a freight claim unless the shipping paperwork has been noted as damaged. Photos of the damage are highly recommended and, in most cases, imperative.

When the carrier arrives to unload the windows, it is your responsibility as the purchaser of the product to fully inspect every window for damaged packaging, cracked or broken glass, bent frames and marred finishes. You, the customer, must note these damages on the shipping papers/bill of lading for a damage claim to be initiated. If damage is found after the carrier leaves, no freight damage claim can be filed. Carriers will not accept concealed damage claims. If packaging looks damaged, it must be noted, and the packaging should be removed to see if damage has occurred.

Due to the important responsibility of the delivery inspection, we highly recommend that a representative of your company be on site for all jobsite and warehouse deliveries. If no one is available to unload and accept responsibility for the delivery, the carrier will be directed to continue its' route without unloading the truck. Any cost associated with re-delivery will be charged to the dealer responsible for the order. Again, we can't help you with a damage claim if you don't inspect and note damage as stated above. In addition, we cannot have the delivery of a load without someone being present to unload the truck and authorized to inspect the load.

The discovery of damage after the fact becomes the responsibility of you, the customer. We want to avoid this situation, thus the reason for this letter.

We value our partnership with you, our customer! Thank you in advance for doing what is necessary to ensure that all parties are protected from unreported damage claims.

Expanse 3-Season Porch Windows with retractable screens include a cut-out on the left and right jamb for a Window Operating Control Device (W.O.C.D.) or Angel Lock. These cut-outs include a plug inserted so that an Angel Lock may be added at the point of manufacturing or as a retrofit.

The Angel Lock satisfies fall protection codes listed below. In other words, the regions that have implemented fall protection code requirements can now install Expanse windows floor to ceiling on elevated decks. This can eliminate the need for a knee wall or railings. Where required, the Angel Lock is a cost-effective solution. Note that codes vary from market to market.



## COMPLIANCE

- Local building and fire codes shall be consulted before installing the WOCDs. Contact the local building code of fire departments for applicable codes.
- Window opening control devices should be installed such that the release mechanism is in conformance with local building and fire code requirements.
- Young children may fall through an open window if all instructions are not followed and the WOCDs are not installed correctly. Please review the Important Safety Information furnished with the WOCD installation instructions.

Expanse EXP50 windows, when equipped with two Mighton Mini Angel Ventlock window opening control devices (WOCDs), comply with ASTM F 2090 window opening control device requirements of sections R310.1 and R312.2 of the 2015 and 2018 International Residential Code, provided the EXP50 windows have been specified large enough to meet minimum opening area requirements for emergency escape and rescue openings under the foregoing codes. It is the responsibility of the window installer and building occupant to follow all WOCD instructions furnished with the windows and WOCDs.

# ANGEL VENT LOCK

## INSTALLATION

1. Locate the two WOCD slot covers on the left and the right side



2. Remove both covers to expose the prepunched WOCD slots. A small flat-tip screwdriver can be used to help remove the covers.



3. Insert a WOCD in each hole, ensuring the WOCDs are oriented as shown.



## OPERATION



All household members six years and older should know how to operate the release mechanism in case of an emergency. The WOCDs should be tested every month to verify proper WOCD operation. Follow these steps.

1. Disengage WOCDs on each side of window by pressing on orange dots.

2. Raise bottom sash past both WOCDs.


3. Lower bottom sash past WOCDs and verify that both devices automatically reset.

4. Raise the bottom sash as far as the WOCDs allow. Verify that the opening at the bottom of the window after testing and verify both WOCDs have reset properly.



## LIMITATIONS

- Follow installation instructions when installing the Angel Ventlock Window Opening Control Devices (WOCDs) on Expanse Porch Windows. Failure to do so may result in accidental window falls.
- WOCDs are designed to protect against accidental operation of windows by children 5 years and younger.
- WOCDs are not a substitute for careful supervision of all young children.
- Keep WOCDs properly engaged unless needed for use in an emergency.
- Install both WOCDs such that a rigid 4.0-in (102 mm) diameter sphere cannot pass through any space in the lower operating portion of the window opening after the WOCDs have been installed.
- Use recommended materials and techniques.
- Make sure that the window frame is in good condition.
- Do not rely on being rescued from windows above 75 feet (6th floor). Follow building fire escape plan.
- Follow instructions to properly operate the window opening control device to open window.
- Never apply padlocks or devices that require a key or tool to unlock the WOCDs.

## HOW TO MEASURE

After adding supporting posts as needed, and framing each window opening, you're ready to collect your final Expanse window measurements. Here's how:

### For Retractable Screens, Transoms, Sidelites, Knee Walls, Filler Panels

- Width - Measure between the jambs at three points: top, middle and bottom.
- Height - Measure from the high point of the sill to the top of the opening - on the left, center and right of the window.
- Depth - Ensure a minimum of 2-1/2" of opening depth between the inside window trim and the outside.

When placing your order, always use the smallest rough opening size. Also note that the actual window will be 1/2" smaller in width and height.

### For Trapezoid and Triangular shapes

- Determine the window type and Left or Right side as viewed from the outside.
- Height - Measure from the high point of the sill to the top of the opening.
  - Trapezoid - Record the Short and Long Leg measurements.
  - Triangle - Record the Height measurement.
- Width - Measure between the jambs at three points: top, middle and bottom.
- Depth - Ensure a minimum of 2-1/2" of opening depth between the inside window trim and the outside.

When placing your order, always use the smallest rough opening size when ordering. Actual window will be 1/2" smaller in width and height than the rough opening size ordered.

## INSTALLATION


Before installing Expanse windows read all instructions in the kit provided with the window. It's recommended that two people work together to complete the installation.

Knowledge and experience with window installation is required to insure smooth operation and performance of Expanse windows which rely on being shimmed plumb and square in the opening. Improper installation may void the manufacturers warranty.

- First, unwrap your new window and discard packaging material. Do not operate window until shipping clips are removed, or while window is laying flat.
- Position the window in the opening and center it both vertically and horizontally, using shims to square and plumb.
- Install the provided screws in the pre-punched holes as indicated in the installation instructions included. To avoid bowing, do not overtighten.
- Fill any gaps between the framing and the window with backer rod and apply non-expanding sealant both inside and out.
- Apply trim, as desired.

## OUR SIMPLE, STRAIGHTFORWARD WARRANTY

The Expanse™ frame is warranted to be free from defects in manufacturing, materials, paint adhesion, or workmanship, under normal use, for a period of two years from the date of original purchase.

### RETRACTABLE SCREEN

The Expanse retractable screen warrants to be free from defects in manufacturing, materials, under normal use, and workmanship for a period of one year from the date of original purchase.

### COMPONENTS

The Expanse components, including glass sash, are warranted to be free from defects in manufacturing, materials, under normal use, and workmanship for a period of one year from the date of original purchase. Upon written proof of purchase, a replacement component will be provided.

### WARRANTY LIMITATIONS

- Warranty only applies to original homeowners of owner-occupied residential properties and covers manufacturer's defects.
- Modification of product will void warranty.
- Damage or breakage of the screen/glass sash is not covered under warranty.
- Acts of nature including wind damage and flooding are not covered under warranty.
- Damages resulting from improper installation or misuse are not covered under warranty.
- Labor cost and re-installation fees are not covered under warranty.
- Damage caused by certain coastal applications, salt, chemicals, or airborne pollutants, such acid rain are not covered under warranty.
- Remedy is limited to parts required to repair and/or replace the defective part or product.

### General care and maintenance

Wash glass using household glass cleaner or a warm water/mild detergent mixture and a soft cloth or paper towel. A solution of four parts water/one part vinegar may also be used.

For general cleaning of the frame, we suggest using a liquid soap and water solution, Formula 409c, Windex, Fantastik®, or similar product. Always follow manufacturer's directions. Using a soft, clean cloth, apply cleaner to a small portion of the surface. After cleaning, rinse the surface completely. Never use acetone or products containing esters, ethers, ketones, aromatic and chlorinated hydrocarbons.
